#### **Description**

This position reports to the Board of Directors.

- Demonstrates a high level of servant leadership;
- Commitment to going ever deeper personally in FICM principles;
- Strong vision for seeing nation impacted with the message of freedom;
- Financially stable and able to function in this self funded position.

##### **Role-specific**

- Demonstrated history of discipling individuals and training Christian believers;
- Experience successfully building, cultivating and stewarding new relationships (for example, partnership development, fundraising or sales) leading to measurable results;
- Able to communicate effectively in English (verbally and in writing) and French speaking an asset but not a requirement with current and potential partners and donors;

- Strong awareness of cultural differences and ability to connect authentically with all cultures;
- Confidence in small and large group presentations and training events;
- Ability to travel within Canada and occasionally globally;
- Previous experience meeting leadership expectations with North America is an asset;
- Develop a national strategy to expose and equip key Christian leaders across the nation with the message and ministry of FICM;
- Develop a strong prayer strategy to undergird the national ministry of FICM;
- Develop a strategy for raising up others to assist in the work of the ministry;
- Develop a plan for translation (if needed), in-country publication (if possible and advisable) and national distribution of core FICM resources;
- Develop a ministry budget and plan for raising needed funds to cover ministry and office expenses, including any support staff salaries (if needed).
